

Legacy Match Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) Enforcement & Detection Controls

Effective Date: June 23, 2026

This document describes the controls, systems, and procedures Legacy Match uses to identify, detect, and enforce violations of its Acceptable Use Policy (AUP).

1. Overview

Legacy Match is committed to maintaining a safe, respectful, and compliant environment for all users. To achieve this, we use a combination of automated systems, manual review processes, and user reporting tools to detect and respond to potential violations of platform policies.

2. Automated Detection Systems

Legacy Match implements automated moderation tools designed to proactively identify potentially harmful or prohibited activity, including:

- Keyword and phrase filtering to detect harassment, hate speech, scams, and inappropriate content
- Image and profile content screening to identify explicit or prohibited material
- Spam and bot detection systems to identify automated or fraudulent account activity
- Behavioral pattern analysis to detect unusual or abusive usage patterns (e.g., mass messaging or repeated unwanted contact attempts)

These systems operate continuously to flag content or behavior that may violate the AUP for further review.

3. User Reporting Tools

Users are provided with in-platform reporting mechanisms that allow them to report:

- Inappropriate or abusive messages
- Suspicious or fraudulent profiles
- Harassment or threatening behavior
- Any content believed to violate platform rules

All reports are logged and prioritized based on severity.

4. Human Moderation and Review

Flagged content and user reports are reviewed by authorized Legacy Match administrators. Human reviewers evaluate potential violations based on platform policies and context, including:

- Severity of the reported behavior or content
- User history and prior violations
- Risk to user safety or platform integrity

Moderation decisions may include content removal, warnings, temporary restrictions, or permanent account termination.

5. Enforcement Actions

When violations are confirmed, Legacy Match may take one or more of the following actions:

- Removal of violating content
- Warning notifications to users
- Temporary suspension of account access
- Permanent account termination
- Blocking of offending users from future access
- Reporting to law enforcement where legally required

Enforcement actions are applied based on the severity and frequency of violations.

6. Continuous Improvement

Legacy Match regularly reviews and updates its detection systems and moderation practices to improve effectiveness, adapt to emerging risks, and ensure ongoing compliance with applicable laws, regulations, and platform safety standards.

7. Limitations

While Legacy Match implements reasonable safeguards, no automated or manual system can guarantee the detection of all violations in real time. Users are encouraged to report any concerns to assist in maintaining platform safety.
